A. Translate into English: (40)

Ἡ Ἀφροδίτη, Διὸς καὶ Διώνης θυγάτηρ, θεὸς ἦν τοῦ ἔρωτος. Ἡσίοδος δὲ ὁ ποιητὴς λέγει ὅτι ἀπ' ἀφροῦ τῆς θαλάττης ἐγένετο, καὶ ἐπὶ τὴν Κύπρον — φιλτάτη δὲ ἡ νῆσος τῇ θεῶ — ὑπὸ τῶν κυμάτων ἠνέχθη. ἐρώσα δὲ καλοῦ νεανίου, τοῦ Ἀδώνιδος, ἀποθανόντος ὑπὸ κάπρου ἐκείνου, βαρέως ἔφερεν. καὶ μὴν πρὸς Ἥραν καὶ Ἀθηναῖν ἤρισεν ἡ Ἀφροδίτη περὶ τοῦ κάλλους· ἔκρινε δὲ Πάρις, Πριάμου υἱός, ὃς τὸ μῆλον Ἀφροδίτῃ ἔνειμεν. ἡ δ' αὐτῶ Ἑλένην, καλλίστην γυναικῶν, ἔδωκεν. ἡ δὲ θεὸς ἡ μῆλον φέρει, ἢ κάτοπτρον, ἢ πελειάδα, ὃ δ' υἱός, Ἔρως, τόξον καὶ φαρέτραν ἔχει.

A. Translate into English: (40)

Τοῖς Βακχιάδαις — λαμπροὶ δ' ἦσαν οὗτοι ἐν τῇ Κορίνθῳ — χρησμὸς ἐδόθη ὅτι ὁ Ἡετίωνος υἱὸς τὴν ἀρχὴν αὐτῶν καταλύσει. ἐπεὶ δ' ἔτεκεν ἡ Ἡετίωνος γυνή, ὡς τάχιστα πέμπουσι δέκα ἄνδρας εἰς τὸν οἶκον αὐτῆς τὸ βρέφος ἀποκτενοῦντας. καὶ παρελθόντες εἰς τὴν αὐλὴν ἤτουν τὸ παιδίον ἐλεῖν· ἡ δὲ γυνή, οὐδὲν εἰδυῖα ἐκείνων ὧν ἕνεκα ἦλθον, ἐνεχείρισεν αὐτὸ ἐνί. καὶ τοῖς μὲν δέκα ἔδοξεν ἤδη τὸν πρῶτον αὐτῶν λαβόντα τὸ παιδίον εὐθύς ἀποκτεῖναι· ἀλλὰ τῶ λαβόντι προσεγέλασεν, ὥστε αὐτὸν κατοικτεῖρειν. καὶ ἀντὶ τοῦ ἀποκτεῖναι παραδίδωσι τῶ δευτέρῳ, καὶ οὗτος τῶ τρίτῳ· καὶ οὕτω διεξῆλθε διὰ πάντων τῶν δέκα, οὐδενὸς βουλομένου διαφθεῖραι.

3. Translate into English:

[80]

(A herald, sent by the Spartan king Archidamus, fails to gain a hearing at Athens.)

ὁ δ' Ἀρχίδαμος, βασιλεὺς ὧν τῶν Λακεδαιμονίων, κήρυκα πρὸς τὰς Ἀθήνας ἔπεμψεν. οἱ δ' Ἀθηναῖοι οὐκ ἐδέξαντο αὐτὸν εἰς τὴν πόλιν οὐδὲ ἤκουσαν, ἀλλ' ἐκέλευσαν αὐτὸν ἀπὸ τῆς πόλεως ἀπελθεῖν τῇ αὐτῇ ἡμέρᾳ. ἔπεμψαν δὲ μετὰ τοῦ κήρυκος ἀγωγούς. οὐ γὰρ ἤθελον αὐτὸν οὐδενὶ συγγενέσθαι. ὁ δὲ κήρυξ, ἐπειδὴ ἔμελλε πορεύεσθαι, εἶπεν ὅτι “ἦδε ἡ ἡμέρα τοῖς Ἕλλησι κακίστη ἐστίν.” δι' ὀλίγου δ' ἀφίκετο εἰς τὸ τῶν Λακεδαιμονίων στρατόπεδον, καὶ ὁ Ἀρχίδαμος ἔμαθεν ὅτι οἱ Ἀθηναῖοι οὐκ ἐθέλουσιν ἐνδοῦναι. προσεχώρησεν οὖν μετὰ τοῦ μεγάλου στρατοῦ εἰς τὴν γῆν αὐτῶν.

δέχομαι: I receive. ἀγωγός: escort. συγγίγνομαι: I meet with.
μέλλω: I am about to. στρατόπεδον: camp. ἐνδίδωμι: I give in. στρατός: army.

4. Read the following passage and then answer *any six* of the questions which follow:

[80]

(Themistocles, journeying through Asia, receives divine information about a plan to kill him by some Pisidians. However, they make a mistake and he is saved.)

ἐπεὶ δ' ὁ Θεμιστοκλῆς ἐπορεύετο διὰ τῆς Ἀσίας μετὰ τῶν στρατιωτῶν καὶ τῶν δούλων, ὁ σατράπης ἐκέλευσε Πισίδας τινὰς αὐτὸν ἀποκτείνειν ἐν τῇ πόλει Λεοντοκεφάλῳ καλουμένη. ἡ δὲ τῶν θεῶν μήτηρ ἐφαίνετο τῷ Θεμιστοκλεῖ καθεύδοντι, λέγουσα ταῦτα: “ὦ Θεμιστόκλεις, μὴ εἴσελθε εἰς τὴν πόλιν· πίπτεις γὰρ εἰς τὸν μέγιστον κίνδυνον. ἐγὼ δ' ἀντὶ τούτου αἰτῶ τὴν θυγατέρα σοῦ.”

ὁ οὖν Θεμιστοκλῆς, αἰσθόμενος τὸν κίνδυνον μέγιστον ὄντα, τὴν ὁδὸν λιπῶν κατηλίσατο ἐν τοῖς ἀγροῖς. οἱ δὲ Πισίδαι ἀφίκοντο καὶ προσέβαλον τῇ σκηνῇ. ἐνόμιζον γὰρ τὸν Θεμιστοκλέα εἶναι ἐν αὐτῇ. ἀλλὰ τύχη ἐκάθευδεν ὑπὸ δένδρῳ. ἐνταῦθα δ' οἱ τοῦ Θεμιστοκλέους στρατιῶται πάντας τοὺς Πισίδας ἀπέκτειναν. ὁ δὲ Θεμιστοκλῆς πολλὰ θύσας τῇ θεᾷ ἔδωκε τὴν θυγατέρα ὡς ἱέρειαν.

στρατιώτης: soldier. σατράπης: satrap (governor of a Persian Province).
ἀντὶ τούτου: in return for this information. αἰσθάνομαι: I perceive.
καταυλίζομαι: I set up camp. προσβάλλω (+ Dative Case): I attack. σκηνή: a tent.
τύχη: by chance. θύω: I sacrifice. ἱέρεια: priestess.

- Which two groups of people were journeying with Themistocles?
- What did the satrap order the Pisidians to do?
- What was Themistocles doing when the goddess appeared to him?
- What did the goddess ask for in return for this information?
- Why did the Pisidians not find Themistocles in his tent?
- Give the First Person, Singular Number, Present Tense of *two* of the following verbs:
ἐκέλευσε, ἀποκτείνειν, ἐφαίνετο.
- Give the Genitive Case, Singular Number of *two* of the following nouns:
μήτηρ, κίνδυνος, δένδρον.
- The word *megalithic* is derived from two Greek words. What are they, and what does each Greek word mean?

(iii) She taught humans how to cultivate corn.

(iv) She was the goddess of archery.

Write a short paragraph about *any one* of the gods or goddesses you have named.

(b) Write a brief account of the life of an Athenian farmer.
